




Start time will be 9am from Daylight Savings Day onwards, so keep that in mind. Coring will be done on Wednesday 18th Sept so there will be no

you are learning your gears, write down the distance of each gear. When you practice hitting 20 balls with your 8 iron find the average distance, then write it down. This becomes your standard length. Do the same with all your clubs. When you play a strange course, having your list of distances will be a great help in club selection. When-ever I give a Lesson I write it down for my "Rising Stars!!" for them to take away & hopefully add to. Every week watching the world stars the first thing they do when they are walking after the tee shot is pull out their personal notes & say "what do I know about the next shot ??"
