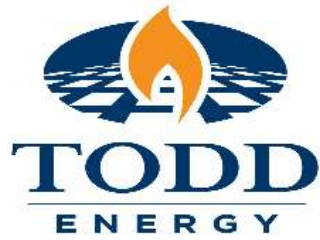

John Garner's golf tips

LEFT ARM CONTROL is a common term used in teaching & likened to using a compass. Putting the pin of the compass into the paper & scribing an arc with the pencil you will make a perfect arc all the time.

The pin represents your head & the pencil your LEFT ARM (RIGHT ARM for Lefties). Keeping the head steady & your LEFT ARM STRAIGHT & FIRM gives you much more control over the club & therefore the ball. The same applies to your PUTTING. Keeping the LEFT ARM & WRIST FIRM is an absolute must to be a sound Putter. You must try not to change the position of the **LEFT ARM & WRIST from start to finish!!!**
