We have a new start time during **daylight savings of 9am.**



There was a field of 27 today playing a Stableford round.

Golfing Tips

The Terms “Square Take Away”, “Square Club Face” & “Square Stance” can be very confusing to all Golfers. The intention of every golfer is to hit the ball forward & the easiest way is if the “Club Face is Square at Impact.” To achieve this fact we stand “Square.” Toes level, hips & shoulders parallel with the intended flight of the ball, i.e. “Square.” Now to explain a “Square Take-away,” is a little difficult so read this slowly & I’ll attempt to resolve a few misunderstandings. We bend from the waist to allow us to create power whether it be 100 metre or 300. We turn on an angle, a tilted plane. When you take the club away to waist high the club face should look closed, but it is actually “Square” to the imaginary Plane of your swing or on the same angle as your spine !! Phew, hope you all got that, if not come for a lesson & I’ll put the kettle on for a “SQUARE CUP of COFFEE !!!”
