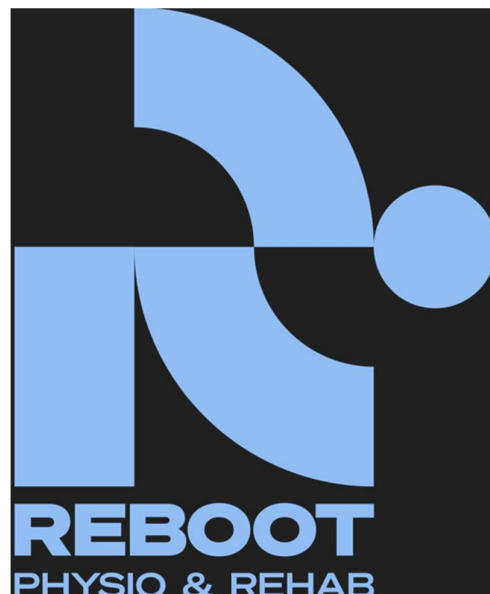

Congratulations to Mike Burkhart was the winner of the Wednesday Strokeplay. Congratulations to the winners of their Matchplay rounds today.

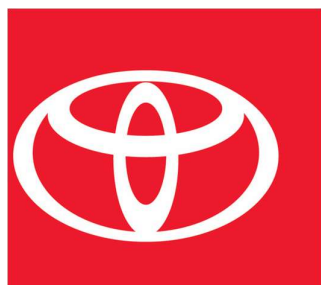

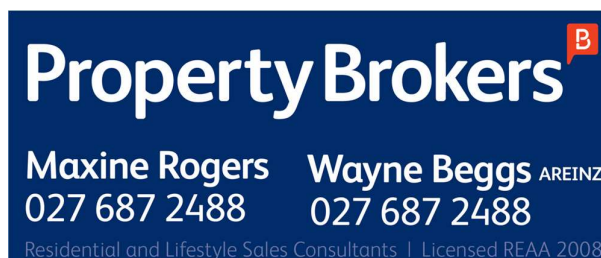
Golfers tend to place too much emphasis on power & not enough on accuracy. **Practice the short game & then INFLUENCE others BY YOUR SCORE!!**
