UP-COMING EVENTS:

7th – August - Manukorihi Cup (Stableford) *Also, this round will double up as the qualifying round for the top club competitions entry's... So, if you wish to have a go at representing OUR CLUB at the Top Club Competition see below for details. Names will need to be entered if you are willing and able to make the 17th of October on finals day so I will enter the winning 4 once we find who has taken out the top spots.*

1. Entry fee is \$120 per team. *(This money is used for prizes for the district final).* Club will pay for entry.
2. The competition format is Stableford.
3. Clubs hosting a qualifying event require a golfer from each of the 4 divisions below.
4. The 4 divisions based on Handicap Index are: *(senior men 10 and below, intermediate men 10.1-20, junior men-20.1+ and Women's open division).* Divisions are based on home course playing handicap. If a winner of the qualifying event is unavailable the club may send a replacement – it is recommended this player be the runner-up.
5. **The district final** to be played over 18 holes at the **Inglewood Golf Club** on **Sunday 17th October 2021.**

August 14th Is the Clarendon Cup Foursomes so grab a partner everybody ...

So Clarendon Cup Foursomes Rules .: Two players per team. In your team you must pick who will tee off the odd holes or even holes once this is decided then one player tees off ...then your partner plays the next shot and then you swap who plays the next shot until the ball is holed. Add your handicaps and divide by 2 and this will be your team handicap e.g. 10.4 plus 20.4 = 30.8 divided 2 =15.4

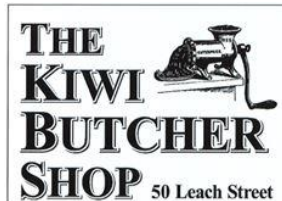

Golfing Tips

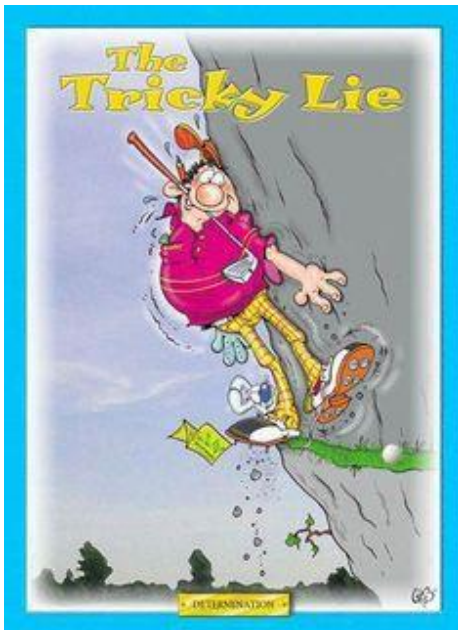
COURTESY to OTHERS & THE COURSE.
