A **Good Posture** at the start, the “Address Position” definitely influences your backswing. As the backswing is the first part of the swing a Good Posture is therefore essential to playing good golf !!! Quite simply Chin Up – Bottom Out – Flex The Knees & “ Lets Go !”

Look at yourself in the mirror to check the front position, the look of standing “ Proud “ & the side view, weight on the heels, arms hanging loosely away from the body without stretching, relaxed. Work on having a **GOOD POSTURE** its very **IMPORTANT !!!**

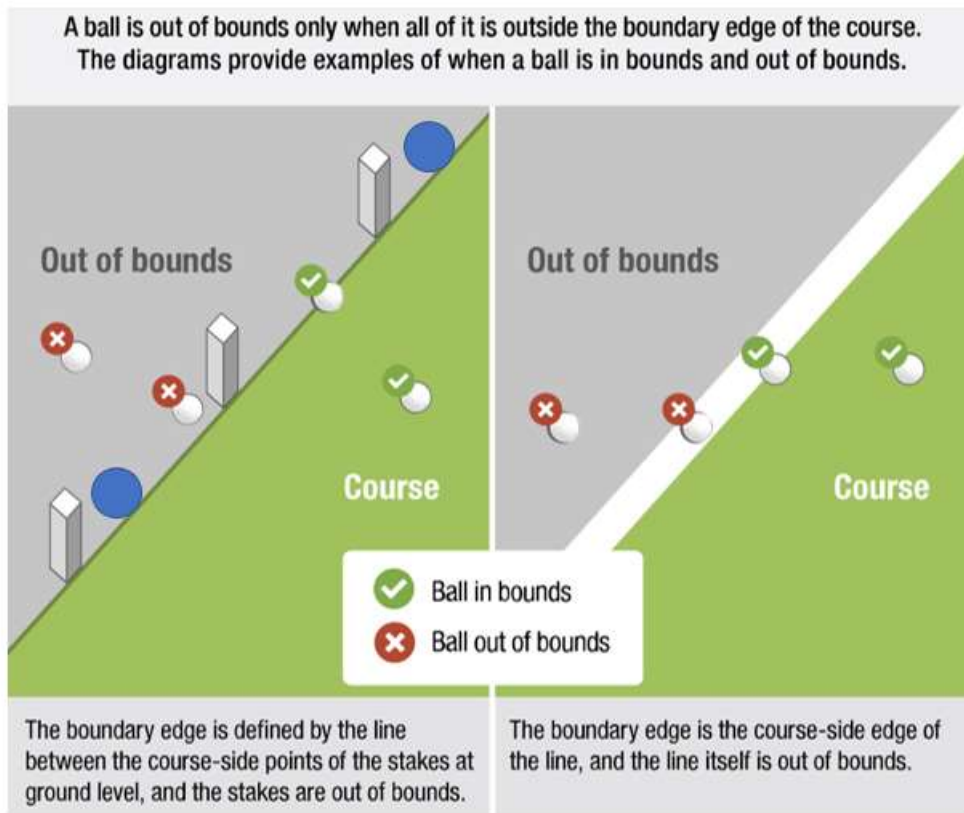
**Rules corner #2: Out Of Bounds (O.O.B)**

The Manukorihi Golf Club has NOT adopted an optional rule which allows players to drop their ball where it crossed the Out Of Bounds line. You must play your next shot under penalty of stroke and distance.

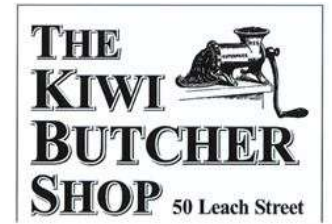
Which basically means you play from where you hit your previous shot from plus a one stroke penalty.

To determine if your ball is out of bounds, the entire ball must be O.O.B.

- O.O.B may be determined by stakes, marker discs, or in some cases a line on the ground.
- The line of O.O.B is a direct line, on the course side of the stakes or markers.
- The ball is in bounds if any part of the ball is on the course side of the line.
