MEMBERS DRAW: Garry Piggot took it out this week (don't forget to put your name down BEFORE you start).

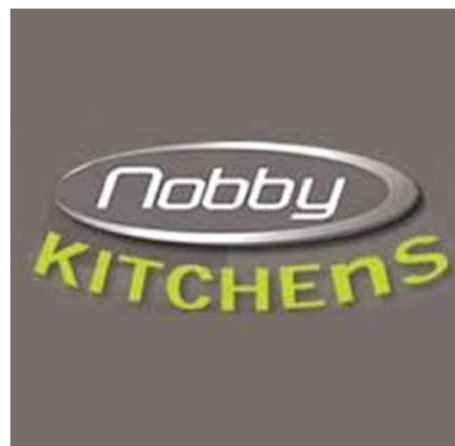
