Five two's scored Darryl Baird, Toko Waitere, Kelly Brown, Gary Crawford & Michael Burkhart.

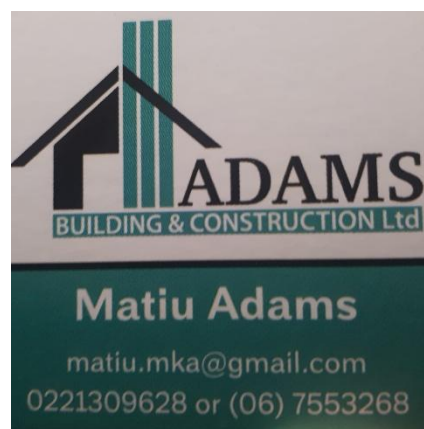

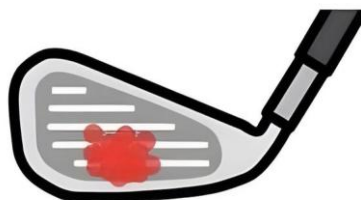

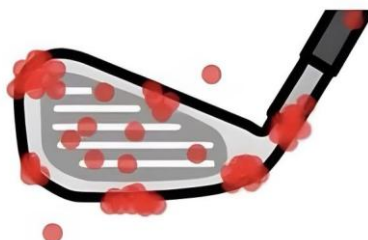

Immoveable scenario #3.

While playing the 18th hole, the player's ball comes to rest beside a tee marker post. The post is an immovable obstruction, the player is entitled to free relief under rule 16.1

Where does the player drop for this scenario?



99% of golfers will take relief on the fairway side of the sign. This will result in disqualification for playing the ball from the wrong place



In this scenario, the **ACTUAL** nearest point of relief is on the tree side of the sign. The nearest point of relief is where the sign no longer impedes your swing. This is a classic example of why you should always identify your relief area **BEFORE** to touch your ball. Remember, once you touch your ball, you must take relief, otherwise you incur a penalty for moving your ball.
