# Immoveable scenario #3.

While playing the  $18^{th}$  hole, the players ball comes to rest beside a tee marker post. The post is an immoveable obstruction, the player is entitled to free relief under rule 16.1

Where does the player drop for this scenario?



99% of golfers will take relief on the fairway side of the sign. This will result in disqualification for playing the ball from the wrong place





In this scenario, the ACTUAL nearest point of relief is on the tree side of the sign. The nearest point of relief is where the sign no longer impedes your swing. This is a classic example of why you should always identify your relief area BEFORE to touch your ball. Remember, once you touch your ball, you must take relief, otherwise you incur a penalty for moving your ball.


