Men's: The winner of the Anderson trophy for the men was Kevin Southee with 47 points

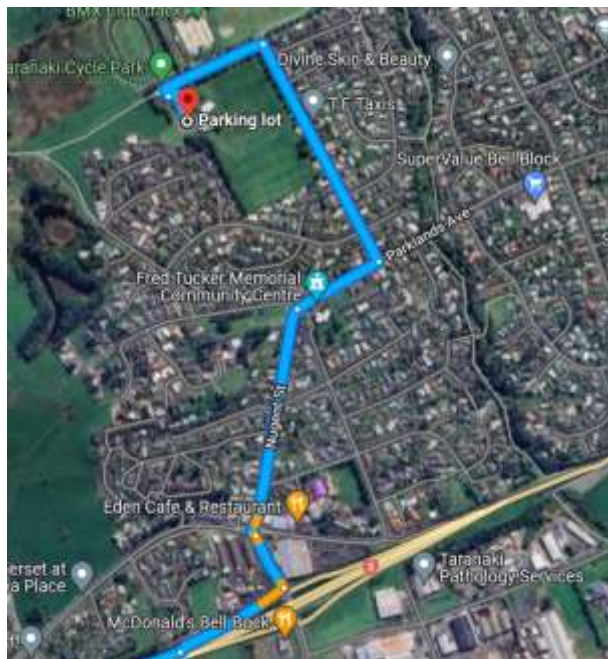
