

John Garner's golf tips


The PITCHING WEDGE is the most flexible club in the bag as it could be used from 1 metre off the green up to 120 metres according to your own power.

Chipping is from about 30 metres & then your shots become pitches. Hits from 30 metres, 40 metres, 50 metres & upwards must be learned through practice. One way to do that is to play 20 balls to an umbrella stuck into the ground.

The shorter the shot the shorter the swing e.g., full swing = 4th gear, ½ swing = 2nd gear & whatever the distance you achieve, is your own power.


