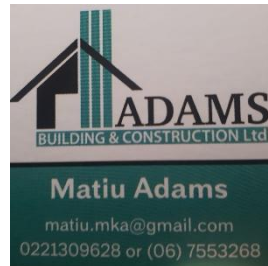

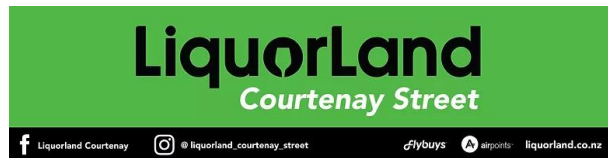
Jason Brown's name was drawn for Chase the Ace but he was unsuccessful. \$180.00 will go forward to next week.
