John Garner's golf tips

The Pitching Wedge is the most flexible club in your golf bag. As I mentioned in Pro – Tip 8 you can use it from 1 metre up to over 100 metres according to the individual. The power is not essential but accuracy is!!! Everyone has basically 4 Gears. 1 – 2 – 3 – 4

4th gear is your normal full backswing (head high approx.) same length follow/through

3rd gear would be a $\frac{3}{4}$ backswing (shoulder high approx.) same length follow/through

2nd gear only $\frac{1}{2}$ a backswing (waist high approx.) same length follow/through

1st gear just a short backswing (leg high approx.) same length follow/through

Having the same length of backswing as the follow through helps you with your **BALANCE!!!**
Hit 20 balls & learn one gear at a time, then you will begin to control that **Pitching Wedge.**
