- Visualise the first bounce of the ball is onto the green. (There are exceptions to this.)
- You can choose an 8 Iron – a running shot
- Or a pitching wedge – a little more height & less roll
- A sand wedge or lob wedge – a lot of height & very little roll

Stance/Posture.

- Very narrow stance & toes level (square)
- Ball middle
- Hands forward opposite the front leg
