Tuesday Ladies Report

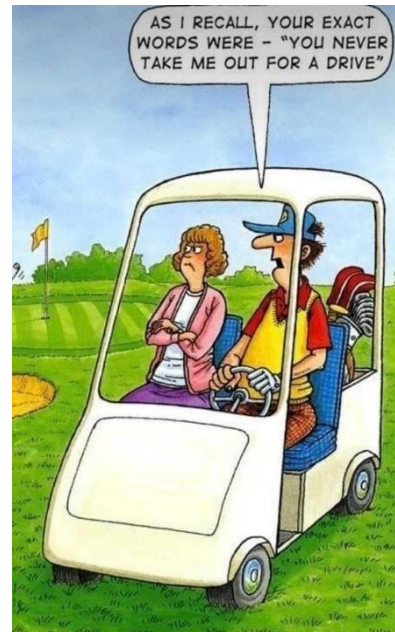

I was listening to a conversation about the swing being likened to a wheel & your head should be in the centre of this imaginary circle & it should be steady at all costs!!! Have we heard this before!!! Now it isn't a vertical circle nor a flat one but between the two at about a 45-degree angle. Little head is stuck in the middle, your arms are the spokes & the ball is at the bottom. Boy this game sounds so easy & yet it isn't!!! The reason being that you can't see yourself as you're swinging & every part of your body is moving on the way back & then on the way forward in only 2 seconds!?!? So, the **BIG TIP** is to imagine a pencil on the end of your club & you scribe an arc backwards & then forwards as smooth & you can. Just like The Great George Duncan did at Royal Cinque Ports, Sandwich, winning with a 4-round total of 303, hickory shafts & gutta percha balls!!!! **HEAD STEADY & THINK OF YOUR CIRCLE!!!**

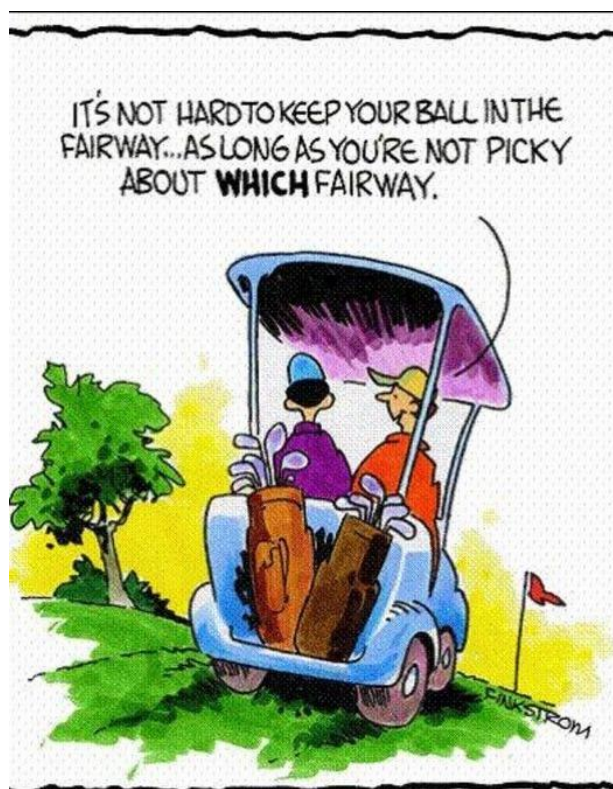

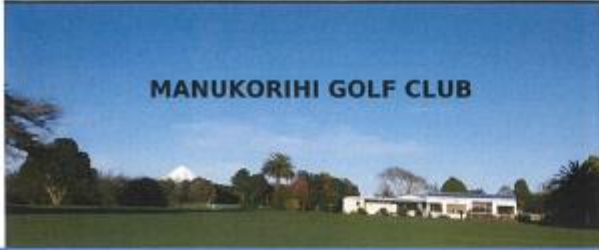
