Club President Report

Committee Meeting

At the request of some members this report is a new initiative to feed back at a high level the main points arising at Club committee meetings. The **first meeting of the year was held on 1st February**, with main points summarised as follows:

- **Secretary:** Trish Crawford's appointment was formalised.
- Club Captain: Jody Bound's reappointment was formalised.
- Vice Club Captain: Subsequent to the meeting, Robert Butler agreed to fill the role of Vice Club Captain, which will be formalised at the next committee meeting to be held on 22 February.
- Carpark Upgrade: A grant application was lodged with TSB Community Trust in mid December, with an outcome expected later this month or early in March. At that stage a decision will be taken as to if and when the project will proceed, and if so, how total project funding will be arranged.
- Seismic Survey: Greymouth Petroleum approached the Club late last year seeking "permission to enter" our course as part of conducting a wider seismic survey over their large petroleum mining permit area. After some negotiation, last week Greymouth generously donated the sum of \$30,000 to the Club to go towards the drilling of a water bore on the course, and the Club granted Greymouth "permission to enter". Over the next two months, Greymouth will be preparing for and carrying out their seismic survey on our course, with their activities monitored and restricted to Mondays and Thursdays. Appropriate health and safety measures will be in place.

The committee expects to proceed with the water bore project following detailed planning, costing and

arranging of total funding, with the likelihood of commencement next year.

Golfing Tips

RULES.



The one thing that every golfer should have in his golf bag is a Rule Book. You can pick one up free in the Clubhouse. Most years there are additions & changes so it would be wise to acquaint yourself to the basic rules at least:

- 1. Out of Bounds.
- 2. Lost Ball.
- 3. Water & Lateral Hazards.
- 4. Ground Under Repair (GUR).
- 5. Unplayable Ball.

My advice would be simply to read about Etiquette on pages 18-21 & The Definitions pages 22-35. These cover most of the vital information that you'll require on a round to round basis. But, if in doubt rather than hold up play, put a 2^{ND} ball in play (a provisional ball). Play out both balls & get a ruling when you get in the Clubhouse. You'll be surprised how many people are willing to give you the benefit of their experience & how many variations to the rule there are !?!?!? **Get yourself a RULE BOOK.**
