
CHRISTMAS HAMPER LAST WEEKEND.

Golfing Tips

The Putting Grip which is widely taught when a golfer first handed place your left forefinger

starts is called the reverse overlapping grip. If you are right

down the outside of your right

hand. It may curl around your little finger or straight down along all your fingers. It is a personal feel, whichever feels comfortable. (Lefties do the opposite of course.) This grip is recommended because it helps keep the **Back of the** Left Hand going forward thus keeping the CLUB FACE SQUARE towards

your TARGET!! In the world of golf there are many different styles & putters but try the

REVERSE OVERLAPPING GRIP FIRST before the others you might just find that YOU LIKE IT !!!



Rules corner: Bunkers


A new rule introduced in 2019 allows you to declare a ball in the bunker unplayable. If you declare your ball unplayable, you have 4 options

- (1) For one penalty stroke, the player may take stroke-and-distance relief. Play from where you hit your previous shot
 - a. Drop within one club length
- (2) For one penalty stroke, the player may take back-on-the-line relief in the bunker.
 - a. Drop within one club length
- (3) For one penalty stroke, the player may take lateral relief in the bunker.
 - a. Drop within two club length
- (4) For a total of two penalty strokes, the player may drop outside the bunker, going back as far as they like keeping the original spot in line with the hole <u>Click here</u> for a short video showing this option
 - a. Drop within one club length
