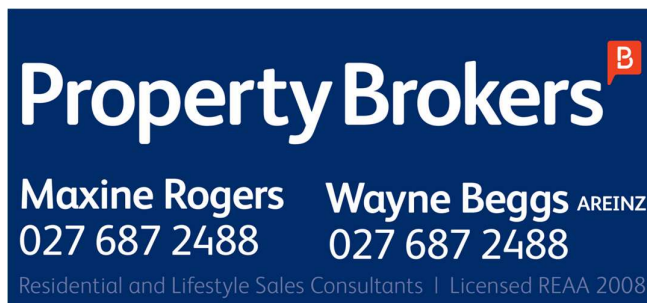
Robert Middleton, Stuart Skene, Jude Mita and Carl Beale had 2s.
