Golfing Tips

I want 100% of your brain focused on **FEEL !!!** If you putt to a hole at this the first stage you are immediately thinking of trying to hole the putt thus 50% of your brain is trying to hole the ball & the other 50% is on feel. **NO !!** This drill is to teach you **FEEL** & I need 100% of the brain on the **POWER !!!** Do this 4 times up & down the green & you will start to **LEARN LONG PUTTING - - FEEL !!!** (1ST ball only 10 paces)
