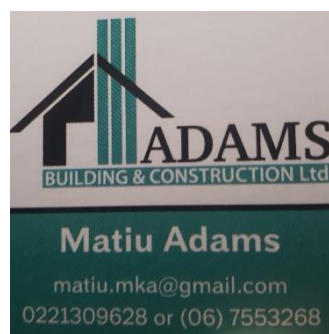

## Tuesday 9-Hole Ladies Report

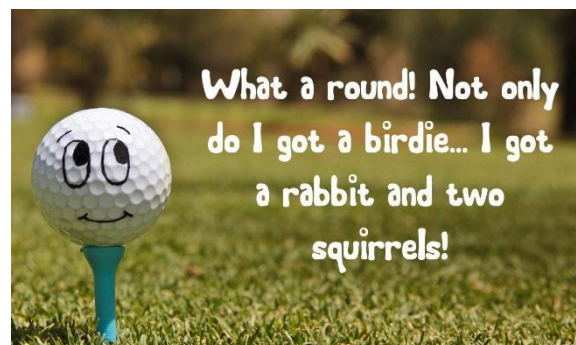
