Golfing Tips

DIRECTION is always a problem, mainly because we stand at the side of the ball & it would be easier if we could line up like a shooter looking down the barrel. So here is the big tip given to us by the great Jack Nicklaus. Firstly stand behind the ball & pick a spot 2 metres in front of the ball which is in line with your target. Now stand to the ball in the normal way but draw an imaginary line from the ball through the square club face & over your predetermined spot. You are now in a square position, toes / hips / shoulders/ parallel to the intended flight of the ball. This is the **PROFESSIONAL** way to check your **DIRECTION !!!**
