PRO TIP - back to basics

Having a GOOD BALL POSITION is

very important & to achieve it consistently you need a routine. An earlier Pro – Tip explained the Circle/Wheel, well if the ball isn't at the bottom of your imaginary circle, you wouldn't hit it, & this is the Professional Routine to ensure that you do! Firstly, have your feet together & the ball positioned opposite your left big toe. (Lefties please do the opposite. Thank you.)

1. Move your left foot out 1 width of a shoe. This stance is for chipping up to 25 metres.

2. Keep your left foot still, now **move**

Best accessory I could have ever put in the bag. 18 tap in birdies today.



your right foot 1 width of a shoe. Pitching & short Iron stance. (Wedges, 9, 8, 7, 6.)

3. Again leave your left foot still & move your right foot 1 more shoe width. Irons 5,4,3,2.

4. Left foot still & **move the right foot 1 more shoe width.** All your long clubs including the "big dog." This stance will be similar to the width of your walk!! For natural BALANCE!!!

5. Notice that your toes are level, bottom out, chin up, knees flexed all ready TO GO!!!




