The Golf Club Committee has authorized the procurement of two essential pieces of course maintenance equipment from Norwood. These include a Trimax Snake Fairway Mower 320 S3 and a Kubota Tractor equipped with a loader and bucket, both of which arrived in August. The acquisition of

this advanced equipment is a strategic step towards enhancing the quality and sustainability of our golf course. These upgrades will support ongoing maintenance efforts, ensuring the course remains in optimal condition and continues to meet high standards of excellence. The committee remains committed to investing in state-of-the-art technology to facilitate continuous improvements and uphold the reputation of our golf facility for years to come.


