As to not inconvenience the members our local competition on the 18th will be a mass start at 9am. More information to come.

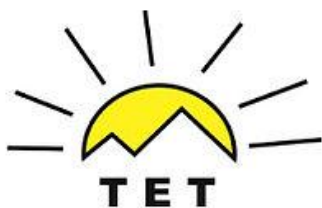
Please come along a support the Speed Golfers as spectators and see how they how they perform. The round times and scores are sure to impress.

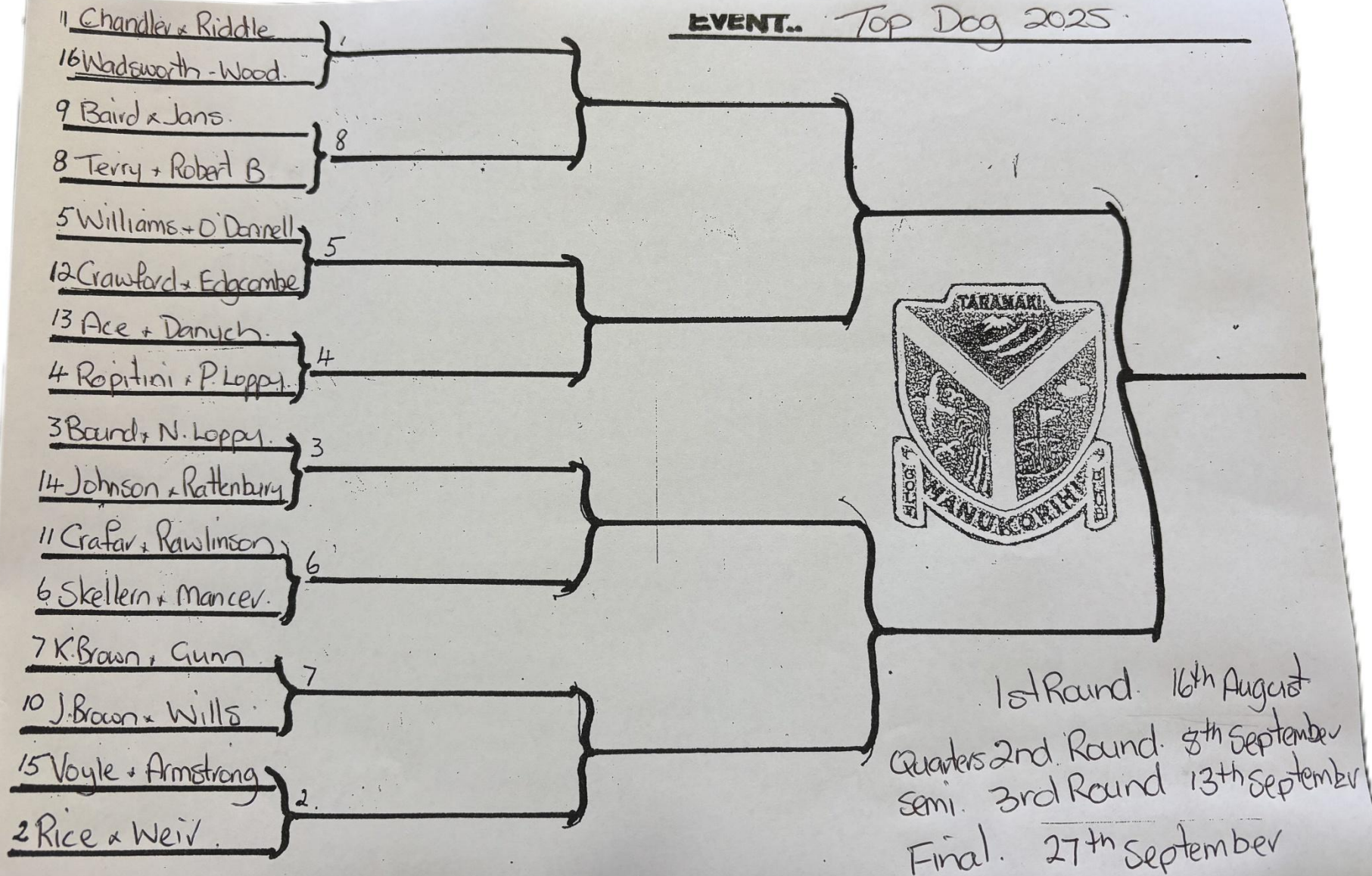


Volunteer's Corner
