The comp is drawn 3 person Ambrose. This is the only day really that we mix up ALL members so let's just have a good day and cup tea together later on ...hope its fine....!

SLOW PLAY TIPS: Getting new golfers, we will get the odd slow play at times and believe me, I KNOW how frustrating this can be.

- Let's set a good pace this year and remember if allowed ...don't mark it a foot from the cup **JUST TAP IT IN HAPPY !!!** then get on the next tee, don't stand around and wait for all to putt out.
- Let the flag in golfers' putt first or last saves flag in / out.
- Let the short hitter in distance **NOT height** go out of turn.
- Fill your score on the walk.
- WALKING THE FAIR WAY TOGETHER IS FINE, but once you reach the closest drive don't all hang around go get ready for your shot.
- If YOUR LIKE ME and chipping out from the trees don't wait just chip out.
- The big ones are Coming back to the tee.
 - Please if you don't see it hit the ground **JUST HIT ANOTHER PROVISIONAL BALL, IT SAVES SO MUCH TIME** (assuming it is the MUST TAKE tee shot).
 - **IF YOU THINK ITS CLOSE TO O.B HIT A PROVISIONAL** (assuming it is the MUST TAKE tee shot).
 - **3 MINS MAX LOST BALL TIME**

If you are a fairway behind and are in no rush let the four behind play through, its only fare, thanks.

Don't get upset if the group in front can't hit as they are waiting to hit in.

All these tips will help the pace of play so thank you. I know some will say old school golf is to let the furthest away play first but unless its match play the rules have changed, so get used to it!!!

RULES :Please keep up with the rules ,I know there are heaps but this is a game and we all need to be on the the same page. If you have a rule debate on the course and can't come up with a answer, MOST of the time we can sort it before you enter your card, so come and see us cheers. Check the local board for rules please.

ALL THE BEST FOR THE UP COMING SEASON :

Shoot out will be run by match committee this year so don't forget your score will not be entered if you havn't paid before hand, at the same as the haggle..... if you do not register the card will not be a counter for the competition.


Tuesday 3rd - ladies opening day 9 am playing 9 holes mixed with 9 and 18. Caterer in attendance.



RULES FOR TODAY'S 3 PERSON AMBROSE

1. Enjoy your day
2. Ambrose with a twist.

Your first hole of the day = all 3 team members tee off. Select the shot you wish to play for your second. **ALL THREE PLAYERS** are back in and play the second shot and continue as per normal Ambrose until ball holed. Your second hole – the persons tee shot used off the first hole sits out – so now you choose from 2 tee shots. Continue as for normal Ambrose with all 3 players playing out until holed out. Your third hole both shots used off previous 2 holes sit out, leaving the last team member to be used off the tee. Only this team member can tee off even if the ball is hit out of bounds, they must replay the shot until it is playable. You **CANNOT** use the other team members to tee off . This format is used in the next consecutive 3 holes and so on for 6 times. So, everyone uses 6 tee shots – 1 every 3 holes.

3. Longest drive 18th hole - divisions men's -and ladies. All able to play tee shots for longest drive. But eligible tee shot/s still to be used to complete hole.
4. All players can tee off on the 3rd for closest to the pin – (Individual Prize) but you must take the allocated persons tee shot not necessarily the closest to the pin
5. Lowest nett score wins day. Course handicaps off white tees for men and yellow ladies. Handicaps added together and divided by 5
6. Cards to be swapped and marked by other playing team. Marking tee shot used as on card.
7. Enjoy your day by challenging the other team for a beer on a hole by hole match.
8. **PLEASE BE AT CLUB HOUSE BEFORE 9 AM SO WE CAN SORT CARDS AND TEES THANKS.**
