

With the weather turning, this rule covers another abnormal course condition: **Temporary Water**

Rules corner #5: Temporary water (also known as casual water)

Definition:

Any temporary accumulation of water on the surface of the ground Some examples of temporary water are

• puddles from rain or irrigation or an overflow from a body of water

Relief from Temporary Water is defined under Rule 16 Abnormal ground conditions

When Relief Is Allowed?

Interference exists when any one of these is true:

- The player's ball touches or is in or on an abnormal course condition,
- Temporary water interferes with the player's area of intended stance
- Water can be seen before or after the player takes a stance (without pressing down excessively with his or her feet).

NOTES:

- It is not enough for the ground to be merely wet, muddy or soft or for the water to be momentarily visible as the player steps on the ground; an accumulation of water must remain present either before or after the stance is taken.
- Your ball must be on the green to get relief from temporary water on your line of play.
- If the water is close enough to distract the player but does not meet any of these requirements, there is no interference under this Rule.
- There is no relief for temporary water in penalty areas

Relief


If there is interference, the player may take FREE relief (Rule 16.1b)


- Relief is One club-length from the nearest point of complete relief in the general area, with these limits:
 - o Must be in the general area
 - o Must not be nearer the hole than the point of relief
 - There must be complete relief from all interference by the abnormal course condition.

NOTE:

- You no longer need to find your ball in temporary water. If it is known or virtually certain that the ball came to rest in temporary water, the player may take relief using the estimated point where the ball last crossed the edge of the temporary water.
 - Once the player puts another ball in play, the original ball is no longer in play and must not be played even if it is then found before the end of the three-minute search time
- Always identify your nearest point of relief before you move your ball. Remember it is the nearest point of relief and it may not put you in a better position.

Relief is one club length from the nearest point where the player is clear of the abnormal condition





This diagram assumes the player is left-handed
