Know your Club Distance. A good golfer knows how far he/she hits each club a poor player does not !! To check hit 20 balls with your 7 iron. Discount the few short poor shots & possibly 4 very good ones & pace to the group where the average balls have finished. This would be your average distance with your 7 iron. Now **WRITE YOUR DISTANCE DOWN.** You should have approximately 10 metres between each club. We all love to hit the ball each day as far as we can but it isn't possible so you need to know your average distance, & this is the way to do it. At my Academy I give a special card out. **YOU'RE WELCOME ANY TIME.**
