

Saturday Golf at Manukorihi

Note: Joll cup Match play is best nett per hole – if all square after the 18th, then play the 1st and so on until a winner is confirmed.

SATURDAY HAGGLE: Changes ARE coming for the haggle. We have cancelled the 2x2s and replaced it with a members draw.

How it will work:

1. Must be in the haggle to be in draw each time
2. If you win and are at the clubhouse you get it all 100% of the pot, which will vary depending on entries
3. If you are NOT there, you will get 50% of the pot
4. The remaining 50% will go to a jackpot and if that gets to a max limit of \$500 then it will be 'a must go', so same rules as above but then the remaining 50% eg \$250 will go to the first drawn in house member.

Players drawn must be in the club house to claim a pick of the prizes.


If no aces are drawn it will jackpot through to the following week.
