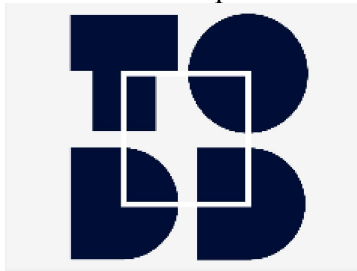

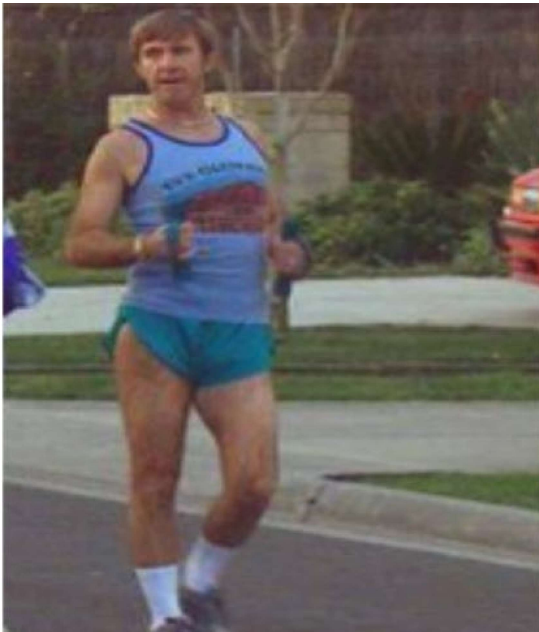
This week it's the semifinals for the TOP DOG so all the best to the remaining 4 and for the rest of us it's a haggie day.

Reminder next Tuesday the course is closed. Everyone is welcome to play at Inglewood.

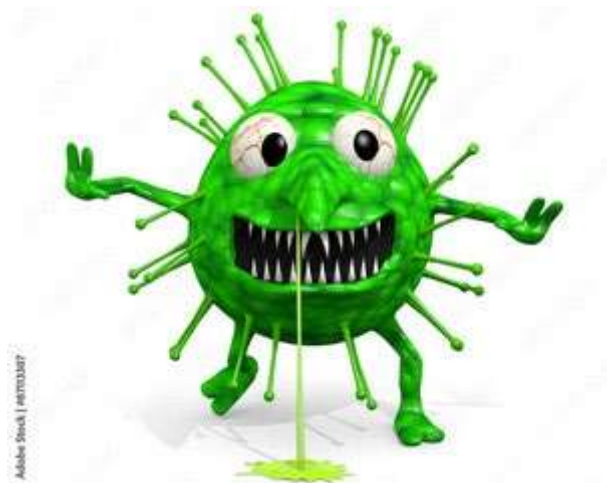

John Garner's golf tips

The “big Hook.”

The hook shot is a better shot than the slice only because it goes further, therefore using a lower club for the next shot but like the slice it gets us into trouble!! Two points to check:

1. **Direction.** Lay a club down on the ground along your toe line, it should be parallel to the intended ball flight to target line (with the hooked shot the club will be pointing right of target).
2. **The Grip** is the other big fault which develops a Hook. Check that you only see 2 knuckles of the left hand (not 3 or 4 !!) And your 2 ‘v’s are pointing between your neck & the right shoulder. (not below your right shoulder !!)

In changing your Grip please be patient as it will not feel comfortable for a while.

Ben Hogan used to say that it takes 500 attempts to make a grip change & if in that time the grip feels comfortable “YOU AIN’T MADE THE CHANGE!!”

Reverse the words right & left for you Lefties.
