PRO TIP - back to basics

USING TOO MUCH BODY in trying to hit the ball is the single biggest fault in playing the game. When you top the ball, your BODY has COME UP before impact. When you slice you have turned your BODY in FRONT of the ball before hitting it. When you sky the ball from the tee you have moved your BODY FORWARD making the swing path too steep.

The Law of SWINGING is to TURN YOUR BODY on the backswing SLOWLY, then from the start of the DOWNSWING LEARN TO SWING YOUR HANDS & ARMS PAST YOUR BODY.

Watch yourself in front of a mirror to get the FEELING.
