Club President Report

AGM & New Committee

The Club's Annual General Meeting was held on 7 December, with 33 members attending.

Main points were as follows (*with healthy discussion on all the motions!*):

- Net profit for the financial year 1 October 2019 to 30 September 2020 was \$54,139, up almost \$5000 on the previous year and an excellent result under challenging circumstances, due in large part to the off-course efforts of our band of volunteers in running competitions, raffles, etc and in manning the bar. *Thank you all.*
- After several years of annual subscriptions being held, a motion to increase 2021 subscriptions by \$10 across all membership categories was tabled and discussed. The main justification is the ever-on-going annual increases in TGA and NZ Golf affiliation fees which have continued to erode the margin for our Club within subscriptions. It was considered preferable to make a small increase at this time rather than keep deferring until the increase would be more substantial. *Motion was CARRIED.*
- A motion to remove the \$10 green fees option for non-members playing with a member and institute a flat \$20 green fees charge across the board was tabled, *Discussed and CARRIED.*
- A motion that all monthly committee meeting minutes should be sent electronically to the newsletter editor for attaching when sending the newsletter out electronically to all members with an email address was *LOST on a close "show of hands" vote.*

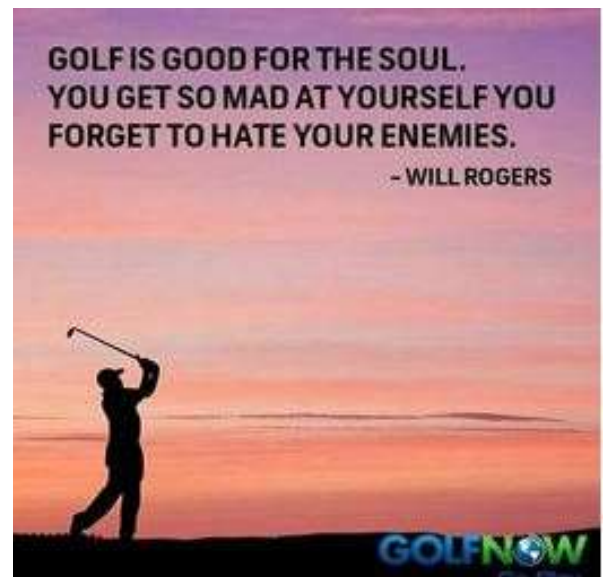
