Membership Subscriptions 2023

We are all experiencing the increased cost of living this year, from the weekly household food bill to the vehicle fuel bill to the domestic energy bill, just to mention three areas. Our golf club is no exception to this situation, with increased operating costs out on the course, in particular for diesel, fertiliser, sprays, grass seed, electricity and equipment maintenance (parts and labour).

While the Committee has invested significant capital this year in the overdue carpark upgrade and sealing project (just under \$50K of Club funds) and in purchasing our own verti-drain/coring machine (\$37K), we are duty bound to try to balance the books in terms of operating income versus operating expenditure. With inflation now running at over 7%, it is looking likely that the Committee will bring a recommendation to the AGM on 5 December for an increase of 7-8% in the base membership subscription for 2023, which could see it rise by about \$0.80 per week to around \$590. The recommendation will be discussed and finalised on 21 November at the last meeting of the year for the outgoing committee.

I just wanted to give members an early indication on this issue.
