PRO TIP - back to basics

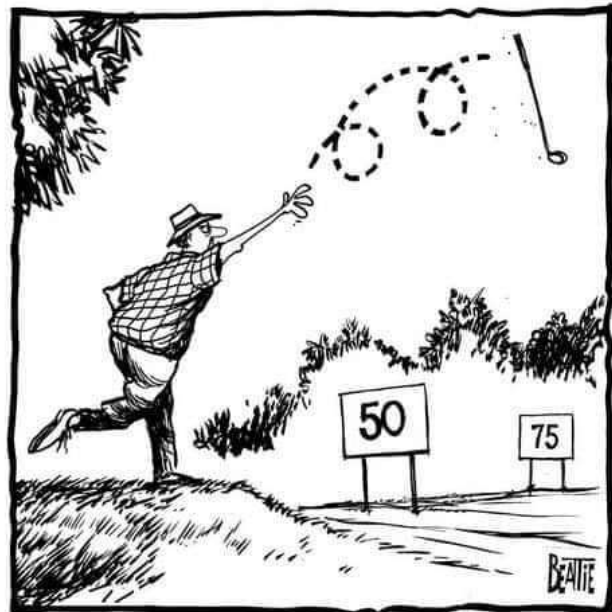
